The Treasurers Report was presented. BALNA has an estimated ending balance of \$1651.00.

A review of the 2012 activities that BALNA participated in include OMN, the Shoreline Museum Presentation, our participation in the used book sale at Swinging Shoreline, 3 separate Night Out Against Crimes parties and the Shoreline Parade.

The next Adopt A Road litter pick-up is scheduled for February 23<sup>rd</sup>.

March 11 will be a special membership meeting to talk to the city about the future of the old King County Decantation site on 25<sup>th</sup> Ave NE. Mark Relph has been invited to present.

Kevin Osborn is organizing our annual food drive at the Ballinger Thriftway on April 6. He will also be talking to Rite Aid to see if we can set up a table there.

Joyce Lingerfelt reported that with much of the garden infrastructure in place and paid for the garden committee has decided to reduce the rental fee from \$45 to \$30 for 2013. There are currently 3 plots available.

Outdoor movie night is set for August 24 this year. There was some discussion about inviting Meridian Park to join with us. Patty Dooley will contact their representative.
